QUEBEC	YES	<p>APRIL 28, 2020: THE RE-OPENINGS, APPROVED BY PUBLIC HEALTH AUTHORITIES, WILL OCCUR IN PHASES ACCORDING TO THE AREAS OF ACTIVITY AND GEOGRAPHIC ZONES</p> <p>STARTING ON MAY 11: ALL CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY WORKSITES CAN RESUME THEIR ACTIVITIES.</p> <p>STARTING ON MAY 25: MANUFACTURING COMPANIES THROUGHOUT QUÉBEC WILL BE AUTHORIZED TO RESUME THEIR OPERATIONS WITH NO RESTRICTION ON THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES PRESENT TO ENSURE SUCH OPERATIONS.</p> <p>STARTING ON MAY 25, RETAIL STORES IN THE COMMUNAUTÉ MÉTROPOLITAINE DE MONTRÉAL WITH DIRECT EXTERIOR ACCESS THAT CUSTOMERS USUALLY USE CAN RESUME THEIR ACTIVITIES. NEW BRUNSWICK	YES	<p>RED: THIS IS THE PRESENT PHASE AIMED AT FLATTENING THE CURVE AND CONTAINING THE VIRUS AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE.</p> <p>ORANGE: THE GOAL OF THIS PHASE IS TO BALANCE THE REOPENING OF SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC SETTINGS WHILE PREVENTING A RESURGENCE OF TRANSMISSION.</p> <p>YELLOW: THE GOAL OF THIS PHASE IS TO FURTHER INCREASE THE REOPENING OF SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC SETTINGS AFTER THE ABILITY TO CONTROL TRANSMISSION HAS BEEN DEMONSTRATED.</p> <p>GREEN: THIS PHASE WILL LIKELY COME AFTER A VACCINE IS AVAILABLE OR MORE IS LEARNED ABOUT HOW TO PROTECT PEOPLE FROM THE VIRUS.</p>	THE PHASED PLAN WILL ALLOW HEALTH EXPERTS TO MONITOR AND EVALUATE THE IMPACT OF THE LIFTING OF RESTRICTIONS. A GUIDANCE DOCUMENT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES DURING THE RECOVERY PHASES IS BEING DEVELOPED AND WILL BE AVAILABLE SOON.	NEW BRUNSWICK GUIDELINES
NOVA SCOTIA	YES	<p>PHASE ONE WOULD BE FOLLOWED BY A 28-DAY TRIAL PERIOD, CULMINATING IN A "RISK ASSESSMENT" TO ENSURE THE LIFTING OF RESTRICTIONS HAD NOT RESULTED IN FURTHER SPREAD OF THE VIRUS.</p> <p>PHASE TWO WOULD ALLOW LARGER GATHERINGS AND ALLOW MORE BUSINESSES DEFINED AS "LOW RISK" TO OPERATE.</p> <p>PHASE THREE WOULD INCREASE "GATHERING SIZE AGAIN – AND NOW 'MODERATE RISK' BUSINESSES/WORKPLACES."</p> <p>PHASE FOUR INCLUDES THE "HIGHEST RISK SETTINGS AND ANOTHER INCREASE IN GATHERING SIZES."</p>	FURTHER INFORMATION ON GUIDELINES YET TO BE RELEASED BY GOVERNMENT. PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND	YES	<p>STARTING MAY 1, 2020: LIMITED OUTDOOR GATHERINGS AND NON-CONTACT OUTDOOR RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES</p> <p>STARTING MAY 22, 2020: SMALL INDOOR GATHERINGS, LARGER OUTDOOR GATHERINGS AND LIMITED RECREATION ACTIVITIES</p> <p>POTENTIAL START JUNE 12, 2020: SLIGHTLY LARGER INDOOR AND OUTDOOR GATHERINGS</p> <p>LOOKING AHEAD: IT IS LIKELY THAT PHASE 4 AND BEYOND WILL BE A NEW WAY OF LIFE, A NEW "NORMAL" FOR PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND.</p>	THE PLAN WILL BE IMPLEMENTED IN FOUR DISTINCT PHASES WITH A PROGRESSIVE LIFTING OF PUBLIC HEALTH MEASURES ON INDIVIDUALS, COMMUNITIES AND ORGANIZATIONS OVER THREE-WEEK PERIODS.
