Calling MP Offices: Stop Tax and Labour Abuse Campaign Patch Through Calling

The Stop Tax and Labour Abuse campaign has created a "patch through calling" tool for supporters to communicate directly with elected officials on the issue of Driver Inc and to advocate for policy change.

By adding voices, as opposed to written word, the campaign is able to take elevate a sense of urgency with decision makers.

Set out below is the script template that supporters are encouraged to use and screenshots outlining the three simple steps necessary to complete a successful phone call through the campaign website.

It is important to note that unlike the quality control and oversight we are able to exercise with our email call-to-actions (review and send on supporter's behalf), with patch-through phone calls, we can't control what supporters choose to say. While we lose a bit of control over the process, all phone calls are recorded, and we are able to track and report on the quality of calls.


Step One

Visit the patch-through calling sign up page:

Upon sign up, users will be redirected to the next step of the process where they can select calling their local MP or a relevant minister's office.






Step Two

Users will be directed to the following landing page:

Users are provided with a script template and options from who on our target list they would like to call. Once they select the elected official they would like to call and hit the 'Call Now' button, they continue through the funnel to Step 3.


I am calling to ask why the government has delayed enforcing the law when it comes to tax and labour abuse that is hurting our trucking sector?

Those tax dollars are meant to help our health care system but are instead kept by those who are breaking the rules and hurting workers.


It's the government's job to enforce the laws and I'd like for you to say what you are doing to ensure the government gets serious about protecting worker rights and enforcing the law?!
